Budget Committee Meeting—
On Zoom—December 10, 2021

Attendees: Greg Fellerman, Chair; Mary Deady, Vice Chair; Cathy O'Donnell, Jerry Mecadon, Joe Burke, Diana Collins, Barry Dyller, John Lisman, Jessica Miraglia, Charles Shaffer, Jim Shoemaker, and Joe Sklarosky, Sr.

The Budget Committee met and adopted a Recommended 2022 Budget that it submitted to the Executive Committee for approval. Among revenues, it adjusted Register advertising rates for inflation and adjusted Estates, General ads, and commercial ads, which had not been increased since 2016. The new rates will be advertised in the December 31st Issue.

The Committee reviewed prices charged and subsidized for members for the Law Day Dinner, Summer Outing and the Bench Bar Conference and voted to keep these the same for 2022. It noted that the Annual Meeting and Quarterly meetings were planned to be held live at the Westmoreland Club in 2022 for which the Association used to charge \$13.00 to members and non-members actual cost. The Budget Committee recommended not raising the cost.

For 2022-2023 Dues that will be due July 1st, the Committee noted that date for 2022 and kept the normal Dues Rate for Members at \$110.00. The W-BLLA YLD Rate is \$45.00, Senior Atty. Rate is \$65.00 and then the Free rate for older members. Members will be invoiced accordingly prior to July. Please remember that some members were grandfathered into Senior and free rates when they were changed several years ago. So, Gail still has those names.

Even with adjusting for the rate of inflation in 2022, Sheriff Sale advertising revenue is expected to be below normal. To offset this, the Budget Committee will be working with the Investments Committee as we move through the 2022 year.

On expenses, the Budget Committee has adjusted for inflation for the planning on all 2022 events and costs. The Deputy Executive Directors received a raise for 2022, and new events for the 2022 year were budgeted. The new events include PA Superior Court holding a judicial session in Luzerne County, installing new carpeting in the Library, Stack Room, and Conference Room, more comfortable chairs in the Conference Room, continuing to use Constant Contact to keep members quickly informed of events and any changes, attending a possible 300th Anniversary Celebration of the PA Supreme Court, and scheduling a new Bar Composite to be taken in 2022 for 2023. The carpeting in the Library was installed in 2000, so it will be 22 years old and is showing its age. The solid green carpeting in Conference Room is even older, and dates back to the 1980s. The Bar Composites are usually taken at ten-year intervals. The one hanging in the Law Library was taken in 2012 for the 2013 Year. So, it is time again for another composite. The bulk of the photos for the 2013 composite was taken at the Bench Bar Conference in 2012, and that proved popular with members. So, this will be explored with Jamie Anzalone and the Bench Bar Committee, if something similar might be worked into the 2022 Bench Bar Conference.

Joe Burke, as Treasurer, will give a report on the Association's finances.

The president thanked all of the members for all of their help during this extraordinary year, including all of the emergency meetings of 2020.

The officers and the Committee thanked Jamie Anzalone, Deb Bolus and Lee Ann White for their 2 years of service on the Committee.

Notice was taken of the Annual Meeting at the Westmoreland Club on January 20, 2022.

The next Executive Meeting will be set by the next president. There was a motion, second and approval for adjournment.

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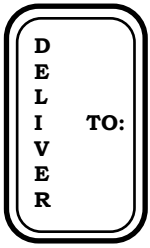
