Rescission of Luzerne County Family Court Local Rules Prior to the Order Entered on December 15, 2022; No. 07803 of 2023

ORDER

And Now, this 28 day of July, 2023, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED as follows:

- 1. The Luzerne County Court of Common Pleas of the 11th Judicial District of Pennsylvania hereby rescinds all Luzerne County Family Court Local Rules with regard to Support, Custody and Divorce, (excluding all Local Rules of Civil Procedure adopted by Court Order of February 16, 2017, docketed to No. 1742 of 2017) as the Rules appear prior to the effective date of the Order entered on December 15, 2022, docketed to No. 00003 of 2022.
- 2. Pursuant to Pa.R.J.A. 103(d) and Pa.R.C.P. 239(c), this Order shall be disseminated and published in the following manner:
 - a. One copy via email to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts;
 - b. Two paper copies to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* and one electronic copy via e-mail saved in a Microsoft format to bulletin@palrb.us;
 - c. One copy for publication on the Court's website, located at www.luzernecounty.org; and
 - d. One copy to the Luzerne County Office of Court Administration, Luzerne Legal Register, and the Luzerne County Clerk of Judicial Records for public inspection and copying.
- 3. It is further Ordered that the effective date of this Order shall be thirty (30) days after the date of Publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

4. It is further Ordered that this Order shall be kept continuously available for public inspection and copying in the Office of Judicial Services and Records of Luzerne County.

W-BLLA Members:



NOTICE

The Temporary surcharge portion of the Judicial Computer Project/Access to Justice/Criminal Justice Enhancement/Office of Attorney General (JCP/ATJ/CJEA/OAG) fee of \$21.25 is set to expire on August 1, 2023. This means that instead of collecting a fee of \$40.25, the correct fee would be **\$19.00** for all filings/recordings that include the fee as of August 1st.

The temporary surcharge may be reauthorized prior to August 1st and thus there would be no change in the overall fee. It can also be reauthorized as part of the state budget once it is passed.

This is notification that if you are filing in person on August 1st or thereafter, base the fee for these filings/recordings on a \$19.00 JCP/JCS fee and bring a separate check in case the fee is reinstated by the legislature. If you are sending your documents through the mail, they may be returned if the fee is incorrect. E-filed or E-recorded Documents/Filings will simply collect the appropriate fee at that time.

If you are unsure of fees or which documents are affected, please contact the appropriate office for your recording/filing. (Recorder of Deeds/Register of Wills/Clerk of Orphans' Court; Prothonotary and Clerk of Courts).

We apologize for the inconvenience. This is advance notice of the possible fee changes. The offices must wait until notification which can happen at any time as to whether the fee has been reinstated as of August 1st.
