In Memoriam The Honorable Hugh F. Mundy

"'A giant' in the community has passed." This was the headline to an article that ran in a local newspaper noting the passing on May 26, 2023, of our revered friend, colleague and family member, the Honorable Judge Hugh F. Mundy. The article and its headline just begins to describe the enormous impact that Judge Mundy had not only on all who knew him, but also, on the countless number of people who benefitted from his service to the community-at-large.

We now celebrate his life and acknowledge the greatness of this man who, as noted below, distinguished himself in virtually all his endeavors. We must observe, parenthetically, that Judge Mundy himself would be interposing an objection to this undertaking, given his trademark self-deprecating humor as well as his self-effacing manner which, of course, endeared everyone to him all the more. Objection overruled!

Judge Mundy served as a Pennsylvania State Trial Judge for the 11th Judicial District (Luzerne County Court of Common Pleas) for almost three decades. He was a graduate of the Saint Francis Preparatory School, Queens, New York (Ring of Honor Member 1958), King's College (B.A. cum laude 1962), and the Notre Dame School of Law (J.D. 1969) where he was Executive Director of the Legal Aid Clinic. Upon graduation, he was awarded a Reginald Heber Smith Fellowship, an award sponsored by the Legal Services Program within the United States Office of Economic

Opportunity for outstanding law school graduates interested in the field of poverty law.

Prior to law school, Judge Mundy attended the United States Naval Officer Candidate School in Newport, Rhode Island (1963). He served two tours of duty in Vietnam and was awarded three Air Medals and a Navy Commendation Medal for missions in support of combat operations in Southeast Asia.

After graduation from Notre Dame, Judge Mundy was approached by the federal Office of Economic Opportunity to see if he could start a federal Legal Services Program for Luzerne County. He accepted the position and started the program, and became the Executive Director of the first federally funded Legal Services Program in Luzerne County.

Following his term with Legal Services, Judge Mundy practiced law with the firm of Winkler, Danoff, Lubin & Toole. During this time, he served as Assistant District Attorney under then District Attorney Patrick J. Toole, Jr. Subsequently, he joined the firm of Flanagan, Doran (later McFadden), Biscontini & Shaffer and, later, became a founding partner in the firm of Dougherty, Mundy, Leventhal & Price.

In 1991, he was appointed by Governor Casey to complete the term of the Honorable Bernard Podcasy upon his retirement. At that time, Governor Casey commended Judge Mundy for "his long record of service to the community and his extensive experience in both civil and criminal litigation." He was elected to his first full term in November of 1991 and was retained by the electorate for a second term in 2001. Upon reaching the mandatory retirement age in May of 2010, he transitioned to serving as a Senior Judge for the next ten years.

Judge Mundy was a fifty (50) year member of the Wilkes-Barre Law & Library Association which honored him in 2018 with its highest award, the President's Award, in recognition of his life and career in the law. Also, he was a member of the American and Pennsylvania Bar Associations, the Pennsylvania Conference of State Trial Judges Education Committee, the Pennsylvania Trial Lawyers Association, the Pennsylvania Defense Institute, and the Disciplinary Board Hearing Committee of the State Supreme Court.

Judge Mundy began his service on the Board of Directors of the Commission on Economic Opportunity in 1988, and, served as President of that Board from 2006 until the time of his passing. Also, he served on the Boards of G.R.I.T. (Washington Square Apartments for Senior Independent Living), United Way of Wyoming Valley, Catholic Social Services, the Boy Scouts, the Back Mountain Youth Soccer Association, and AAA. He was a recipient of several awards and certificates of appreciation, including the Monsignor Andrew J. McGowan Leadership Award, Friendly Sons of St. Patrick Man of the Year, and the BSA Silver Beaver Award.

No tribute to this remarkable man would do him justice without some further comment regarding his sincere devotion to family, his extraordinary professional skill, his unique ability to "bring out the best" in others, and his passion for the game of golf and the enjoyment and

friendships he gained from that pastime. As a family man, no subject brought Judge Mundy to smile as brightly as the mention of his beloved wife, Dr. Rita Ryan Mundy, their daughter Maura, their son Hugh, or their granddaughter Ryann Rossi, for whom he had a special fondness. The Judge actively involved himself in all the sports and other activities of his children when they were young. That dedication carried over to his support for their educational and professional endeavors where both distinguished themselves and about which he was duly proud. More recently Judge Mundy would regale friends and colleagues with stories of his granddaughter Ryann's quick wit and comebacks to "Grandpa," his pride evident that Ryann was the third generation to possess the Mundy gift for "dry humor." While he never boasted of their many accomplishments, all who knew Judge Mundy recognized that his family was his pride and joy and their success and well-being his most ardent concern.

As trial advocate and later judge, Judge Mundy's written and oral presentations were clear, precise, and delivered with an uncommon "smoothness" that in his early years won him the respect of adversaries and the Bench, and later earned him a sterling reputation among those appearing before him. His former partners and associates had utmost regard for his integrity and skill; his former judicial clerks characterize his mentorship as central to both their personal and professional formation and success. Whether as counselor, advocate or jurist, Judge Mundy's capacity to understand complex legal issues, defuse and resolve conflict, and show respect for both the citizenry and the rule of law served as the hallmarks of his endeavors.

Judge Mundy is described by his many friends as the "friend everyone hopes to have." Some might attribute that to his "every man" demeanor, given to waxing about the prospects for each year's edition of Notre Dame football, or the chances for his Giants to get to the Super Bowl or his Mets to get to the World Series. Others might insist that it was his willingness to listen and offer wise counsel and support when friends faced adversity. To a person, Judge Mundy's friends acknowledge that his way of proceeding seemed both an example and an invitation to always try "to do the right thing."

Golf, how he loved the game and how the game loved him. Judge Mundy played as often as possible throughout his life, with several holes in one and a few "even par" rounds to his credit and the delight of his playing companions. Notable among these was the late Judge A. Richard Caputo with whom Judge Mundy shared a passion for discovering the "perfect set of golf clubs." Judge Mundy's many golfing friends and acquaintances came from all walks of life, in keeping with his persona where he, in the words of Kipling, could "walk with kings but not lose the common touch." For those who had the good fortune to join him for a round of golf, they experienced not only his capable game, but also his genuine collegiality and delightful sense of humor.

Judge Mundy spoke often of his love and admiration for his late parents, Mr. and Mrs. (Jean) Hugh A. Mundy and the critical role they played in forming his sense of obligation to live with integrity and serve others. That tradition lives on in the personhood his and Rita's children, the Honorable Maura B. Mundy, Esquire, a highly regarded Workers'

Compensation specialist who was recently appointed by the Governor as a Commissioner on the Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Appeal Board, and Attorney Hugh M. Mundy, an accomplished trial advocate and Professor of Law at the University of Illinois Chicago Law School.

May the many lessons of Judge Mundy's life and career of service be carried forward in the lives and work of all those who were privileged to know him. We celebrate his life and legacy even as we mourn his passing.




When you e-mail your legal notices and ads to Kristin at Law.Library@luzernecounty.org she will e-mail you a confirmation that it has been received.
