Winner Announced:

Finalists will be interviewed by an advising Scholarship Committee. Following the interviews, a winner will be selected. The scholarship is paid in thirds annually to the law school with the first check being paid by the Luzerne Foundation and presented at the W-BLLA Summer Outing held in July. The next two checks are provided to the law school at the start of the fall term of the 2nd and 3rd years.
